A lifeguard, by definition, has a legal duty to protect the safety of people in an assigned area. Lifeguards have a professional obligation to prevent potential accidents by enforcing the rules and regulations of an aquatic setting and to react to any emergencies that occur. To be a professional lifeguard, a person must have a certain level of physical fitness, certification of lifeguard training, first aid, and cardiopulmonary resuscitation and other requirements that may be tailored to the specific needs of the facility.

In addition to these requirements, lifeguards need certain personal characteristics, knowledge, and skills to function effectively. Lifeguards must be caring, strong, quick to respond, confident, physically fit and intelligent persons with good interpersonal skills. Because of the hazardous duty of the lifeguard, some candidates with physical or mental conditions may be certified as lifeguards but may not be qualified for the job of a professional lifeguard. Lifeguards must have a high level of physical fitness at all times, including hearing, sight, speed, strength, endurance and flexibility, all of which are vital to a rescue. A professional lifeguard must be able to remain alert with no lapse in consciousness; be physically able to sit for extended periods, including in elevated chairs; communicate verbally including projecting one's voice across large distances; be able to hear noises and sounds of distress even outside one's vision.
